



WHO WE ARE

The Women's Football Alliance (WFA) is the largest, longest running, and most competitive women's tackle football league in the world. Women's tackle football teams and leagues have been in existence for over four decades, but the most promising growth in the sport – both in the number of teams and in the level of competition – has taken place over the last five years. The WFA was founded in 2009.



OUR TEAMS

The Women's Football Alliance consists of 60 teams across three divisions. Each Spring our teams play a 6-game schedule over the course of eight weeks. Our teams consist of 11-on-11. The season will culminate with Championship Week, where the top two teams in each division will battle it out to determine a National Champion.



RECOGNIZED AT THE PRO FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME



The Pro Football Hall of Fame announced that it plans to recognize the WFA National Championship Team in the Pro Football Hall of Fame Museum each year. The first weekend of August will not only be the weekend for the prestigious gold jacket ceremony with the new class of Hall of Fame inductees, but it will now be the time when the WFA National Championship team MVP will be on display. This year Allison Cahill received this honor for her stellar performance leading the Boston Renegades to their third straight WFA National Championship Title. Cahill also became the first Quarterback lead a women's tackle football team to 6 national titles (2010, 2011, 2014, 2018, 2019, 2021), surpassing the mark of five set by Kim Grodus of the Detroit Demolition (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007).



WOMEN'S FOOTBALL ALLIANCE IN THE NFL

he WFA has broken many barriers. It was the first women's football league to play a National Championship in an NFL stadium, as well as the first women's league to have its games broadcasted on national television. In addition, over 15 veteran WFA players have earned coaching and scouting positions in the NFL including Katie Sowers (San Francisco 49ers), the first female to coach in a Super Bowl, and Jennifer King (Washington Redskins), the first female African American coach in the NFL.




